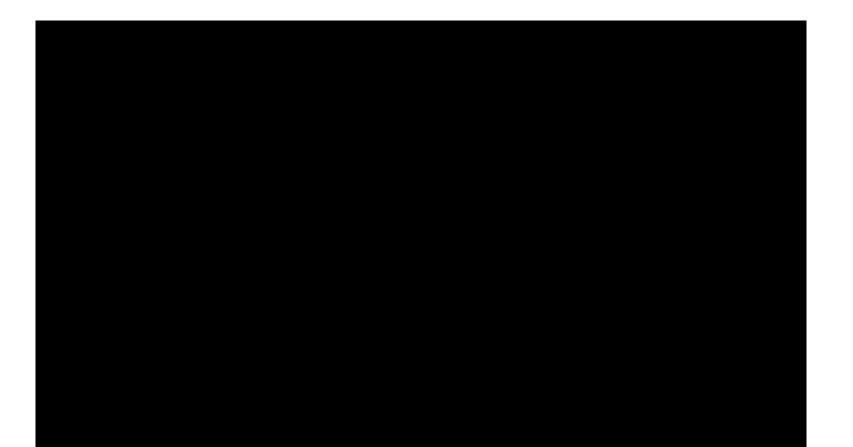

3. Build momentum ...

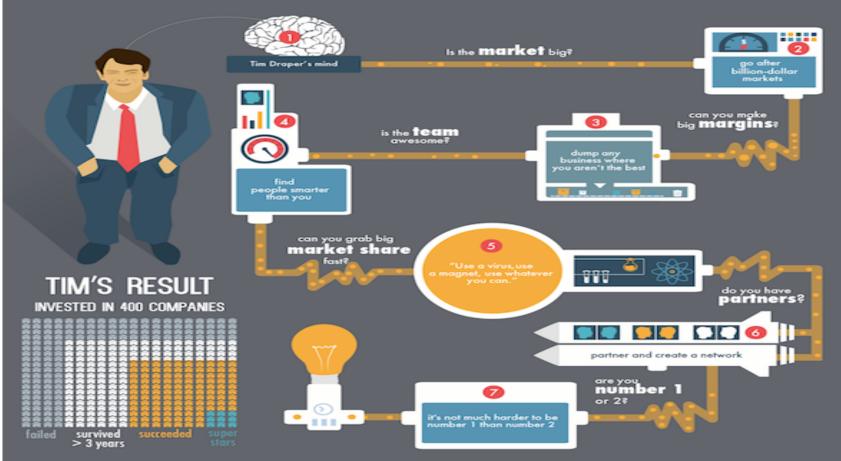
... get experts in the field to ratify and help.

... start building in earnest.

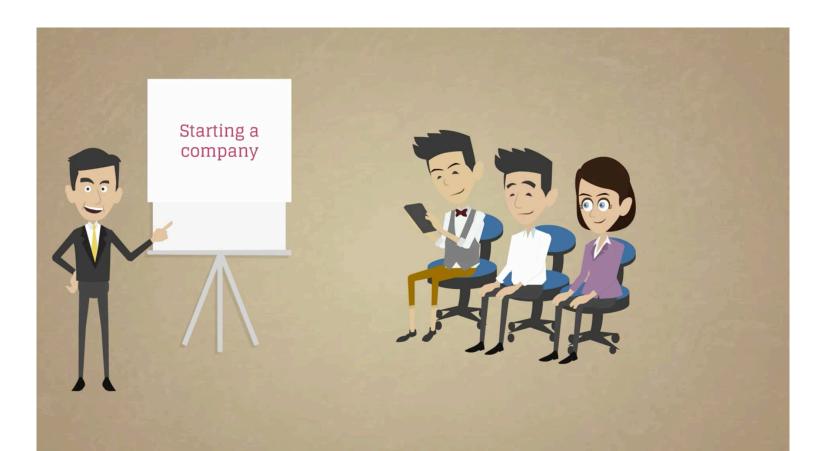
... Incorporate ... Get Investment ... Run (Fail Fast) ...

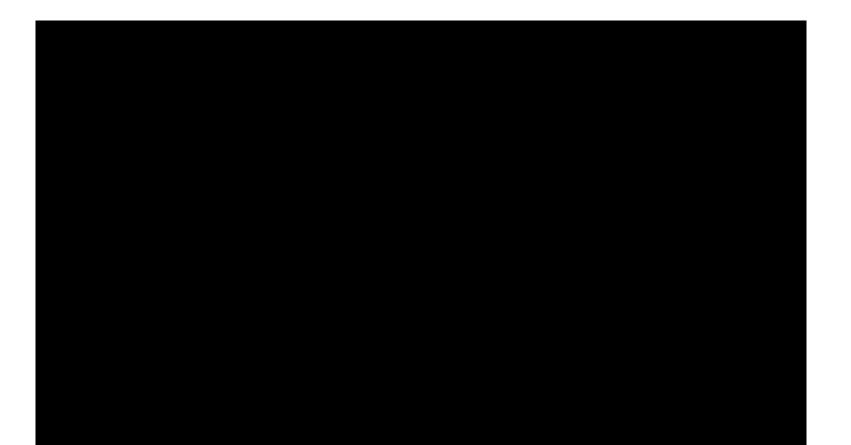


Building a Team

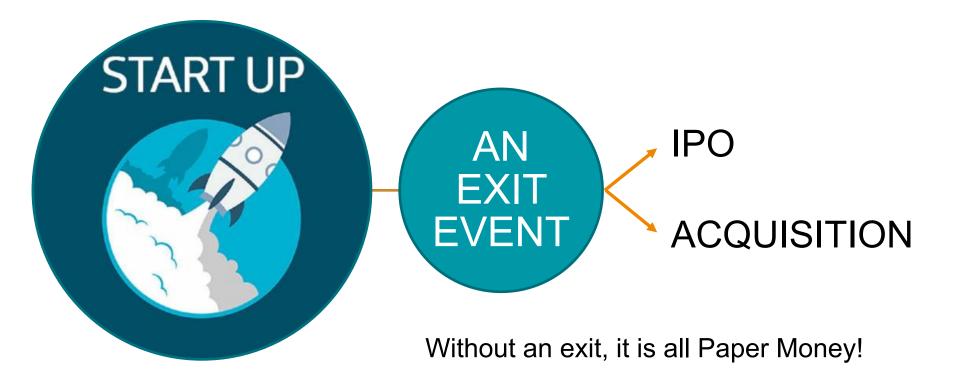
- VCs invest in the team, not necessarily in the idea.

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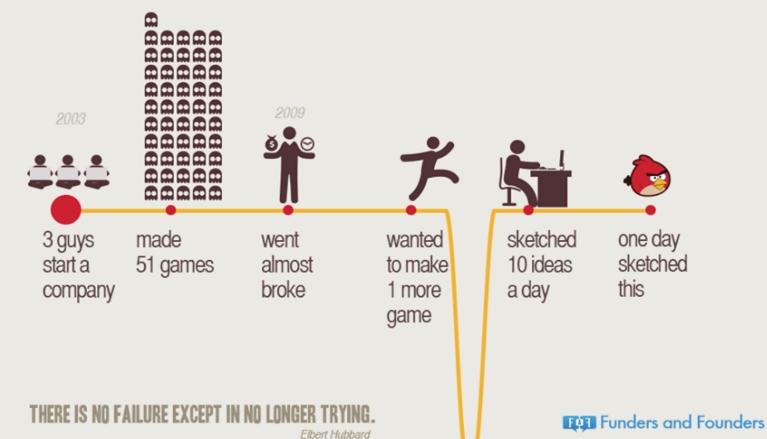

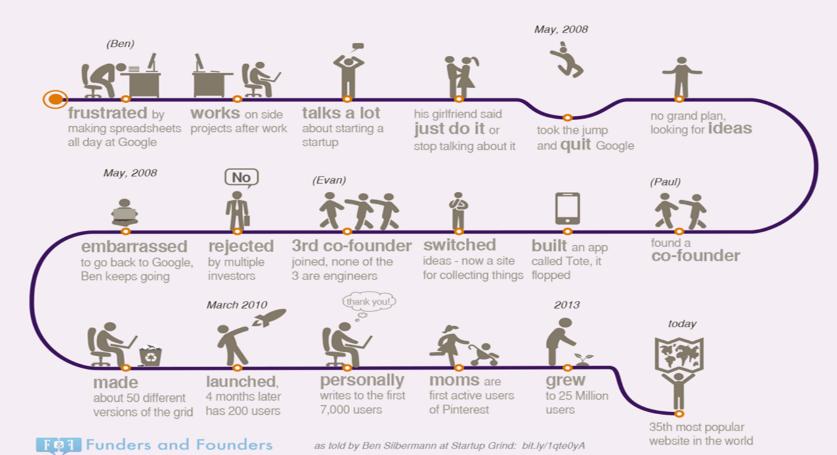

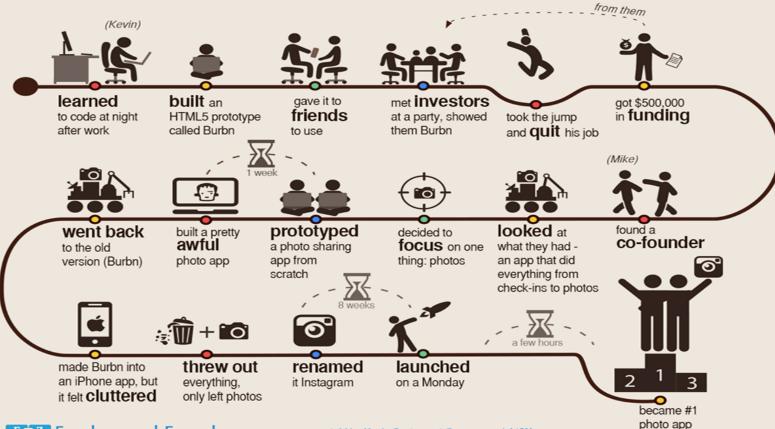

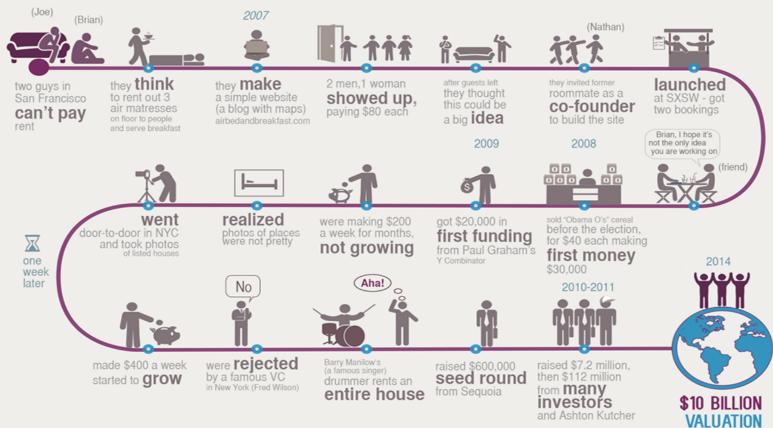
